

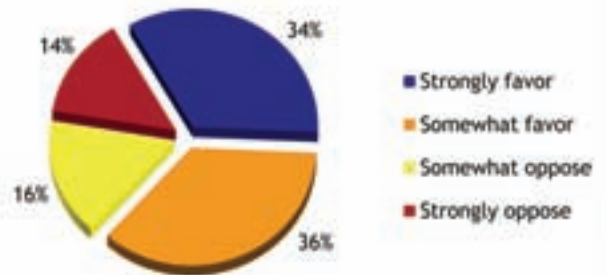


Americans Favor More Funding for Stem Cell Research
